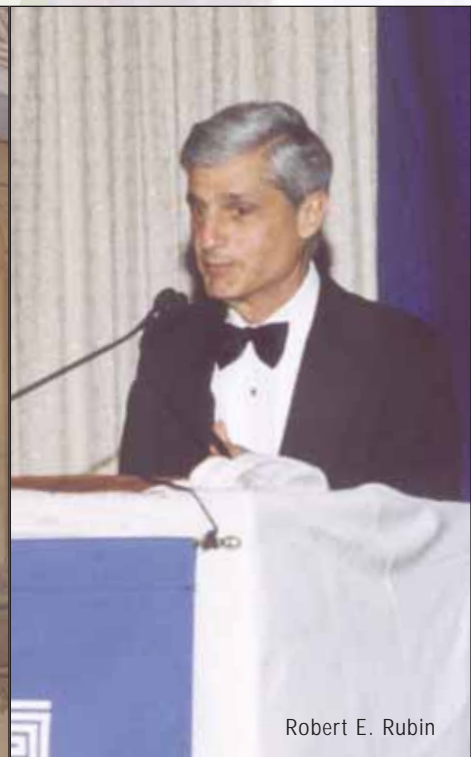

Over 850 guests attended the 2003 Annual Dinner of The Korea Society, which was held in the Grand Ballroom of The Pierre. The co-chairs of the dinner were Mr. Kun-Hee Lee, chairman & CEO of Samsung Electronics Co., Ltd., and The Honorable Robert E. Rubin, chairman of Executive Committee of Citigroup, Inc. The guest of honor for the event, His Excellency Roh Moo-hyun, president of the Republic of Korea, delivered the keynote address. The 2003 Van Fleet Award was bestowed on General Raymond G. Davis USMC (Ret.), who earned the Medal of Honor for his service in the Korean War. The evening's program also included a message from His Excellency Kofi Annan, the secretary-general of the United Nations, which was delivered by The Honorable Maurice Strong, under-secretary-general & special adviser to the secretary-general for the Korean Peninsula. Musical interludes were performed by soprano Hei-Kyung Hong, accompanied by Stephen Eldridge, and the International Sejong Soloists.
